What is the Tidal Bore?

The tidal bore is the lead wave of the surge of water that enters the Shubenacadie River system. In other words...it is the lead wave of the incoming tide. This wave can range in size from a just ripple in the water to as big as a 10ft wall of water! The surge of water is created by the high tides of the Bay of Fundy being funneled into the river. The tidal bore advances at approximately 14km/hr depending on the size of the tide.



Where do the rapids come from?

The rapids are created by the *huge* volume and velocity of the incoming water. After the tidal bore goes by, the river reverses direction and starts flowing in at about 28 km/hr. This water flows over the enormous sand bars. The sand bars force the water up in big swells called *standing waves* that can range in height from 3ft-15ft.
