In 1874, William D. Lawrence launched Canada's largest wooden hulled sailing vessel and helped to establish Maitland as a shipbuilding empire.

Located in the province's first municipally designated Heritage Conservation District, Lawrence's home helps tell the story of the shipbuilding industry in Nova Scotia's "Golden Age of Sail".
